Tamader Al-Tarifi Awad Al-Karim was the former Federal Minister of Education of Sudan, as well as the Undersecretary of the Federal Ministry of Education. She was responsible for national planning and policy for education, including coordination and standardization of curriculum development, teacher qualifications framework, and secondary school certificate examinations. While in office, she also worked closely with international development agencies for educational improvements in Sudan, such as creating a publishing house for education materials. Prior to her position in the government, she was a secondary school teacher from over 30 years. She holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education and Higher Diploma in Senior Education from University of Khartoum.
